

How to get on the Dunes

TRAILERING A VEHICLE?



This applies to ALL ORV/ATV/Motorcycle (non-street licensed/no plate) vehicles requiring to be trailerd - Non-street licensed vehicles ARE NOT permitted on any local roads unless in the designated areas in and around the ORV Welcome Center/ORV Scramble Area.



Required Permits

Your ORV/ATV/Motorcycle (non street licensed) MUST have all three of the required permits. An ORV Trail Permit, and ORV License and a Michigan DNR Recreation Passport. If your recreational vehicle needs any of these permits, they may be purchased at the **ORV** Welcome Center.

DRIVING

#2: Do you have a mounted safety flag & is your vehicle ready?

ALL vehicles on the dunes must be "Dune Ready" to make sure your vehicle is dune ready, review the following requirements below: -

DUNE READY VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

- SAFETY FLAG: Your square safety flag MUST be mounted and secured to vehicle at the following positions:
- > "Sit-In" Automotive style seating. Flag mount to the front-most portion of the
- > "Sit-On/Straddle" style seating, (steered by handlebars) Flag mounts on the rear of the vehicle.



If you need a flag, you may purchase one at one of our local vendors like; Silverback Offroad or Duneland Offroad Center at the entry area of the dunes.

- ALL TIRES MAX 15 PSI (recommended 12-15 psi)
- VEHICLE SOUND LEVEL AT 94db OR LOWER
- "SIT-ON/STRADDLE VEHICLES ALSO REQUIRE: Helmet, Spark Arrestor, & **Eve Protection**

PARKING FAQ 4-WHEEL DRIVE MUST be engaged (turn off "traction control" if equipped)

A VEHICLE?



This applies to ALL vehicles that are street licensed vehicles with a license plate.

PARKING VOUCHER GUIDE

WHEN ARE YOU ARRIVING

On a Weekend or Holiday two weeks prior to Memorial Day weekend until Sunday after Labor Day Weekend?

Proceed to the **ORV** welcome center to get your voucher. Vouchér distribution begins at 8am on Friday FOR

Parking Lot Vouchers will be for two periods: 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. or 8

Saturday & Sunday

vouchers.

a.m. to 9 a.m. Parking Lot Stand-by Vouchers will be distributed once parking spaces for those periods are exhausted.

NO voucher needed

Proceed to the Main ORV parking Area or the ORV Welcome Center Area to park and prepare your vehicle to enter the dunes.
